A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

A WORD

Blessed Easter brothers and sisters. May the new life granted in Christ Jesus bring you great joy and hope!

I write to you as those who have been made members of Christ Jesus our Lord, his body elected, regenerated and made complete

in him in faith alone. He is the one who makes us new, who in his resurrection not only signals new life, but makes it complete in us as His Holy Spirit brings us to faith, trusting in Jesus to be our life. It is to His cross that we have been traveling across this Lenten desert. It is in the Holy Spirit that we are fasting, praying, searching Scripture, worshiping and partaking in the faith-filled conversations of God's children with God's Holy Spirit working in you making us each into God's children even as we bring the 40 days of Lent to a close culminating in the Holy Week.

As we come to the conclusions of Lent in just a few brief weeks, it is my prayer that these last couple weeks will bring rich growth along with a deeper more abiding trust that God is at work in your life as a source of your renewal in Him. Though this call to grow is in no way limited to the Lenten Season, it has been my ongoing prayer that for each one of you God has been meeting with you over these 40 days that you might better know Him and His will in your life through Christ Jesus.

Now why write you "mid-journey?" The narrative of God's people is full of the stories of both those who heed God's call and those who do not. Jesus himself even taught in a parable of two brothers, one who told his father that he would come to the vineyard, never to appear and the other who refused the call to work, and

later arrives unexpectedly to fulfill his father's bidding.

Though we are each called, it may be THIS Lent that finally finds any one of us at last molded and shaped by the Word to now arrive at God's vineyard, ready to encounter God's will in our new, lives. It is never too late to arrive, it is never too late to begin... it is never too late to be transformed by the us to Word of God for "today" is ever the day of cross transformation and salvation in Jesus our Good and esert. Glorious savior.

As we near Holy Week and Easter I'd ask you to ponder what it is to be granted new life in Jesus. How has His resurrection become for you your own? What in you has been discovered to yet be in need of being brought to life in Him? What would it mean to arrive at a tomb of death only to discover that no longer are you being held in it's depths instead to discover that led by
